Shakespeare Goes To War, a World Premiere Comedy-Drama, written and directed by **John Fisher** begins in the 1970s as Jack goes off to high school, unsure of himself and his place in the world. There Jack meets his great inspiration, an English teacher named Harry Smith. Harry introduces him to Shakespeare, acting, and the magic of theatre. Harry also shares his experiences of being a prisoner of war in a German prison camp during World War II. There he met his own surprising inspiration: the crafty and deceptive Colonel Klambach, camp commandant. The play is set in the P.O.W. camp in 1944 and at Jack's high school in 1978. 1978 was the time of the notorious Brigg's Initiative in California - a ballot proposition designed to fire all gay public school teachers - that now threatens Harry's career. As Harry faces his own challenges in the past and present, Jack learns that he might be able to help Harry, through his use of a surprising weapon – Shakespeare.

John Fisher adds: "Shakespeare Goes to War will use Thick House in a dynamic way. We will place the action on the audience risers and the real audience onstage. I've always loved the steep mountain shape of the audience with all its stairs and railings. Our set designer Jon Lowe suggested we put the action for one of our shows on these audience risers. "Shakespeare Goes to War" was specifically written to utilize this exciting space. The action goes up and down the stairs, over the railings and to every part if the theatre. The audience itself is seated on stage and even there they will be surrounded by action."

BIOS:

John Fisher (Playwright/Director/Harry) is a playwright, director, actor and teacher. Recent work includes his play *To Sleep and Dream* (2014 Bay Area Theatre Critics' Circle Award for Best Script) and his direction of the Theatre Bay Area Award-winning production of Alan Bennett's *The Habit of Art.* Last season John appeared as Alan Turing in *Breaking the Code* (Eureka Theatre) and directed the West Coast Premiere of David Mamet's *The Anarchist.* He will direct and appear in his new comedy-drama *Shakespeare Goes to War* (11/15, Thick House.) John's plays include *The Joy of Gay Sex*, which was produced Off-Broadway, and *Medea: The Musical*, which was produced as a part of the HBO Comedy Arts Festival and ran for 18 months in its original SF production. John is a two-time winner of the Will Glickman Playwright Award, and a recipient of two NEA Project Grants, an SF Arts Commission Grant,

the GLAAD Media Award for Best L.A. Theatre, two *L.A. Weekly* Awards, the *BackstageWest* Garland Award, two Cable Car Awards, the *SF Bay Guardian* Goldie Award, and five Bay Area Theatre Critics' Circle Awards. He holds a Ph.D. in Dramatic Art from UC Berkeley and has taught at UC Berkeley, UC Santa Cruz, A.C.T. and at the Yale School of Drama. Recent work includes *SexRev: The José Sarria Experience*, a Theatre Rhino production at CounterPULSE. Recent directing projects include *A Lady and Woman* at the Eureka Theatre and *Food Stories* for Word-for-Word. Since 2003 John has been Executive/Artistic Director of the GLAAD Media Award-Winning Theatre Rhinoceros, the longest running LGBT theatre in the nation.

Kevin Copps (Bachman/Maitland/Briggs/Reagan/Thompson) recently appeared in Theatre Rhino's *Breaking the Code*. He has appeared with many Bay Area companies, including Sleepwalkers, No Nude Men, Theatre Q, Willows and Ragged Wing. Productions have included *Proof; The Cherry Orchard; Gross Indecency: The Three Trials of Oscar Wilde; Mame; Entertaining Mr. Sloan; As Bees in Honey Drown; Camping with Henry and Tom and <i>The Dining Room*, among others.

Sean Keehan (Ryker/Conroy) is an actor, designer, and media producer. He studied acting at ACT and UC San Diego, where he graduated Cum Laude. Gabriel A. Ross (Jack/Harry Jr.) Gabriel is excited to be back with Theatre Rhinoceros after appearing in the 2015 Spring production of *Timon* (Board of Supervisors). He has performed in the Bay Area for over 10 years.
